<b><u>Determinate, Compact</u></b>		
Black Sea Man	70 days	mahogany brown fruit & olive green shoulders; 8-10 ozs
Early Annie	65-70 days	med. size; orange/red fruit; drought tolerant
Fargo Yellow Pear	65 days	prolific - great for small gardens
Farthest North	50 days	very early; great for containers; prolific cherry - sets in cool temperatures
Manitoba	65 days	vigorous plants that thrive in cool climates with short seasons
Matchless Tomato	80 days	6-8 oz med fruit in clusters of two-three
Mountain Princess	68 days	Very productive and early; great for short, cool seasons
Silvery fir tree	55-60 days	compact; perfect for containers
Sophie Choice	65 days	red fruit; good flavour; great for small gardens
<b><u>Cherry</u></b>		
Blondkopfchen (little blond girl)	70 days	indeterminate; yellow
Chadwick Cherry	75-80 days	indeterminate; red; 2.5-3cm fruit; highly productive & diseases resistant
June Flame	75 days	(aka Jaune Flamme) indeterminate; orange fruit; 2-3 ozs; good for drying
Pink Bumble Bee	70 days	indeterminate; pink stippled yellow; great tasting
Rideau Sweet Cherry	70 days	indeterminate; great tasting; extremely productive
Sun Rise Bumble Bee	70 days	indeterminate; orange skins streaked with yellow
Sweet Million Red	60-65 days	indeterminate; vigorous & disease resistant
Sweet Million Gold	70 days	indeterminate; gold form of Sweet Million Red, disease resistant
<b><u>Large</u></b>		
Andrew Rahart Jumbo Red	80 days	indeterminate; great slicer; dense & meaty; exceptional taste & aroma
Black Early Tomato	70 days	intermediate; 10-12 ozs; dark reddish black with green shoulders; gel capsules inside are green
Italian Heirloom	75-80 days	outstanding; great for eating fresh, canning or salsa; easy peel; red fruit
<b><u>Oxheart</u></b>		
Kim's Civil War Oxheart	65-70 days	early; pink, meaty oxheart; few seeds; long season
Livingston's Giant Oxheart	80-90 days	indeterminate; approx. 3lb fruit; meatiness; low acid; mild qualities; pink & some green shoulders; heart shaped
Monomakh's Hat	70 days	semi determinate; large heart-shaped fruit; up to 2 lbs; good tasting
Portuguese Bullheart	75 days	indeterminate; very productive; red fruit & green shoulders
<b><u>Yellow/Bicolor</u></b>		
Mary Robinson's German Bicolour	90 days	indeterminate; fruit are yellow with red at blossom end; up to 2 lbs
Gold Medal	80-85 days	indeterminate; 1 lb fruit yellow with rose flesh sweet & mild & low acide
Morden Yellow	65 days	determinate; very productive; good flavour w/ med. size yellow fruit
Old German	75 days	indeterminate; like a Caribbean sunset; red/orange/gold colours
Rutger	75 days	indeterminate; great season long productive red tomato
<b><u>Roma Type</u></b>		
San Marzano	80 days	indeterminate; pasta sauce
Cup of Moldova	75-80 days	indeterminate; deep red fruit 2.5-3.5" long; pear/plum shaped; abundant
Roma	75-80 days	determinate
